



Sonoma County (Q2 2024), by unique job postings









#### **METHODOLOGY & SOURCES**

This report offers a snapshot of the job market in Sonoma County during the Second Quarter (April, May, June) of the calendar year. Data from unique job postings is collected by Lightcast Analytics, including: top employers, occupational groups, job postings, median annual salaries, largest employers, top skills and certifications. Lightcast is unable to access any non-publicly posted jobs, so data may not reflect the hiring demands of all Sonoma County employers. Labor market information was compiled from the California EDD and the BLS. Historical unemployment rates represent the average unemployment rate of the 3 months making up the quarter.
